## Fr James

**A description of modern day living** came to me out of a 40 year old poem. Writing of life in a crowded city, with people and houses “packed neatly together”, the poet described the situation as “civilized loneliness”. It's a harsh comment but also very true, and 40 years on, has not lost its validity.

Moving about the parish I notice the quietness of the streets; neighbours are rarely outside talking with one another. In the 20 or so apartment blocks in the Thorndon area, there is silence in the corridors and little interaction among tenants. There is politeness in the lifts but few invitations to visit or socialise. Security is the first priority.

Our school could be like that, with families scattered across the Greater Wellington map, but fortunately the children forge links and friendships develop. It takes effort to build the kind of community where people look out for each other and appreciate contact, but it's so necessary. “Civilized loneliness” disfigures and cripples community. No one wants that.
