Tonga consists of 176 islands of which only 40 are inhibited. There are 6 main islands. In the north is Niuafo'ou, Niuatoputapu and the beautiful Vava'u, central is the enchanting Ha'apai and in the south is the largest island Tongatapu and the mysterious 'Eua. Nuku'alofa is the capital of Tonga and is situated on the main island of Tongatapu.



Tonga is the only country in the South Pacific to never have been colonised by a foreign power and also lays claim to be the first place in the world to see the rising Sun.
