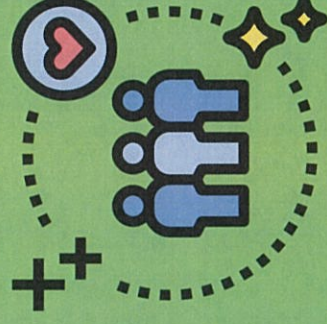


Sacred Heart School Gospel Values
